- University Relations presented at the May Annual Meeting with participation by UC Merced senior leadership


Our Journey with UC Merced

- UC Merced sent us their application with 3 departments:
 - 1. Environmental Systems
 - 2. Physics
 - 3. Cognitive and Information Sciences
- The Assessment Committee and then the NCC Board voted unanimously to move the UC Merced application forward
- The active membership of ARCS NCC voted overwhelmingly in support of UC Merced's application (98%)
- The ARCS National UR Committee voted unanimously to recommend approval of UC Merced and the three departments by the ARCS National Board


- Fastest university to achieve the prestigious Carnegie R2 research classification; UC Merced is on track to reach Carnegie R1 classification in record time

- Why is UC Merced ready to be an ARCS partner?
 - Strength of leadership and financial support/ sustainability -- Excellent! Leading public university in the world starting a new campus with full support.
 - 2. Scholar support -- Extensive! (exemplary student:faculty ratios; supportive programs; outstanding mentoring; etc.).
 - 3. Faculty -- Impressive! (recipient of many prominent grants; significant scholarly publications; prestigious positions in professional organizations; etc.).

FAQ's

- 1. Is UC Merced sufficiently advanced in its academics and research to be a partner with ARCS NCC?
 - Yes. UC Merced has achieved remarkable success and has a proven track record as a research and teaching university.
- 2. Will funding ARCS Scholar Awards at UC Merced decrease the funding of scholars at our other six NCC university partners?
 - No. The UR Council and the Board are committed to maintaining and growing our current funding allocations while bringing in UC Merced.

FAQ's

- 3. Will there be sufficient US citizens in the graduate student population to receive Awards?
 - Yes. With 64% of UC Merced graduate students being US residents (currently 460 and growing fast, and a higher percentage than at many research universities), there will be many qualified candidates.
- 4. Will the distance to UC Merced be a factor in our partner activities -- for both scholars and members?
 - No. While further from the Bay Area than our current university partners, we do not see this as an obstacle, nor does UC Merced.
